

## COACHES VS CANCER IDEAS USED BY COMMUNITIES

- Relay for Life Committee collecting free will donations at door
- 50/50 raffle
- Halftime shoot for soda
- Cancer bracelets sold in school and allowing students to wear hats and teachers to wear jeans
- Bar-B-Q feed with all proceeds going to CVC
- Local banks and businesses offering donations such as: \$1 per point scored, \$2 for offensive rebounds, \$1 for defensive rebounds, etc.
- Get a sponsor to donate prizes. Many schools raffle off the prizes after selling tickets. Some gave fans an opportunity to shoot a

free throw in order to win. One school sold pink pieces of paper to make into a paper airplane. The airplanes were thrown onto the court at halftime. Closest to the center circle wins a prize.

- Sell paper "bricks" to players, fans or parents and put their name on the "brick" and put them on a wall in the gym. Their theme was "build a wall against cancer". The wall grew throughout the season.
- Some schools had a competition between clubs and sports with the winner being recognized at a basketball game and given a pizza party afterwards hosted by the basketball team. Other schools had the boys and girls compete with each other or combine for a fund raiser.
- Competition between elementary classrooms /travel teams, etc. to see who can bring in the most pocket change. Recognize the class/group at a game and/or reward them with treats.
- Silent Auction with items to be auctioned

displayed in hallway and slips, buckets, etc to place bids by each one.

- Recognize cancer survivors in the community.
