



MBCA COACHES VS. CANCER

The Minnesota Basketball Coaches Association has selected the weeks of January 25-30 and February 1-6 as MBCA Coaches vs. Cancer weeks for High School basketball in Minnesota. Schools may choose dates that lie outside these two weeks if they choose to do so.

All Boys Head Basketball Coaches should have received a Coaches vs. Cancer Toolkit from the American Cancer Society around the first week in October. The toolkit contains valuable information on the initiative plus it also provides ideas for creating interest in the event, facilitating the event, and promoting the event. Participating schools may take shipping costs from the funds received from their event or if they wish may send an email to MBCA Executive Director, Tom Critchley, noting the costs of shipping and the shipping charges will be refunded immediately upon receipt of the information.
