Minnesota All-Academic Basketball Team: Sponsored by the Minnesota Basketball Coaches Association Basic Requirements:

- The player must be nominated by their respective head coach. The head coach must be a member of the MBCA.
- The candidate must be a senior who is a starter.
- The player must carry a 3.5 (cumulative) grade point average in an academic core curriculum in his sophomore, junior and first semester of his senior year.
- The player shall not have any Minnesota State High School League eligibility penalties during his high school career.
